

# **Focused Academic Career Tracks (FACT)**

The purpose of the proposed FACT Program is to allow students who desire to focus elective studies on a specialized area of pharmacy or specific skill development the opportunity to obtain concentrated training and recognition to enhance their professional education. This program will allow students to be uniquely positioned with diverse skills by elevating student learning, experience and success. It holds the potential to help students be increasingly marketable upon graduation and a greater asset to advancing the health of communities we serve, in addition to making wider connections in the pharmacy community.

Three distinct and broad tracks are offered, Business & Administration, Public Health & Epidemiology, and Research.



## **FACT Program Goals:**

To provide students the opportunity to:

- Focus on elective studies, a specialized area of pharmacy, and/or skill development
- Obtain concentrated training
- Receive formal recognition to enhance their professional education
- Work 1:1 with pharmacy faculty and professional pharmacy practice mentors in focused area

### **Program Outcomes:**

- Develop, integrate and apply knowledge from the foundational sciences (pharmaceutical, social/administrative/behavioral, and clinical sciences) to evaluate the scientific literature, explain drug action, solve therapeutic problems and advance population health and patientcentered care.
- Identify problems; explore and prioritize potential strategies; and design, implement, and evaluate a viable solution.
- Effectively communicate verbally and nonverbally when interacting with an individual, group, or organization.
- Examine and reflect on personal knowledge, skills, abilities, beliefs, biases, motivation, and emotions that could enhance or limit personal and professional growth.
- Demonstrate responsibility for creating and achieving shared goals, regardless of position.
- Engage in innovative activities by using creative thinking to envision better ways of accomplishing professional goals.
- Exhibit behaviors and values that are consistent with the trust given to the profession by patients, other healthcare providers, and society.

#### **Curricular Requirements\***
