Introductory Pharmacy Practice Experiences (IPPE)

Purpose: Expose students to common contemporary US practice models, including interprofessional practice and direct patient care activities and establish a solid practice foundation on which students will continually build as they progress through the Doctor of Pharmacy curriculum.



Minimum 300 hours of experience balanced between community and health system settings

Placement: Purposely integrated into the didactic curriculum and consistently expose students to activities, in graded fashion, to enable growth in student's abilities
