Class of 2022 Graduate Satisfaction

- **98.6%** of UMKC graduates as compared to **95.0%** of graduates nationally agreed or strongly agreed that they are prepared to enter pharmacy practice
- **77.7%** of UMKC graduates as compared to **74.6%** of graduates nationally agreed or strongly that that if they were starting their career again, they would choose pharmacy
- **95.9%** of UMKC graduates as compared to **82.6%** of graduates nationally would choose the same pharmacy program if starting again
