

The Doctor of Pharmacy (Pharm.D.) program requires satisfactory completion (grade of C- or higher) of all specific pre-pharmacy college course work before entry into the Fall semester. For required minimums and course notes, see the UMKC Pharmacy Admissions site at <u>UMKC Pre-Pharmacy Course Requirements</u>.

Below are the courses that have been approved to transfer from the **listed school** towards pre-pharmacy requirements. Admission to the Pharm.D. program is competitive, with college grades, Pharmacy College Admission Test (PCAT) scores, pharmacy experience, communication skills, and a formal interview being key determinants. A degree is not required for admission.

Courses listed below meet the UMKC pre-pharmacy course requirements for the Pharm.D. program. Please note that the courses below do not necessarily reflect what other programs at UMKC consider towards a Bachelor's degree.
