Class of 2023 Graduate Satisfaction

- **99.2%** of UMKC graduates as compared to **94.5%** of graduates nationally agreed or strongly agreed that they are prepared to enter pharmacy practice
- **79.2%** of UMKC graduates as compared to **77.3%** of graduates nationally agreed or strongly that that if they were starting their career again, they would choose pharmacy
- **92%** of UMKC graduates as compared to **81.8%** of graduates nationally would choose the same pharmacy program if starting again
