Selective #1 (Fall)	3.5. Cultural sensitivity	7279, 7280, 7325/7325L, 7414/7414L Cultural sensitivity concepts introduced in the Spring P1 year and reinforced in the Fall P2 year will be better understood through empathy.
Selective #2 - (Fall)	3.2. Education	Currently 7279 provides an opportunity for students to interview a patient and to tailor their messaging for this audience. 7414 introduces health literacy. Additionally, this will assist with bridging education concepts in the P2 year until students re-visit in the P3 year.
SOAP Note to Self-(Spring)-all students required	4.1 Self-Awareness	7101, 7279, 7280-Students apply the concepts of a SOAP note using themselves as a “patient” and Assess and Plan regarding their current knowledge base strength and weaknesses.
Selective #3 - (either semester)	4.2 Leadership	7101-Students will build on information from 7101 Fall P1 and can select from a listing of Leadership opportunities or create their own with the approval of the DCC. Additionally, this will assist with bridging leadership concepts in the P2 year until student re-visit in the P3.
Selective #4 - (either semester)	4.3 Innovation / Entrepreneurship	7233-Students will build on information from 7233 Spring P1 and can select from a listing of Innovation opportunities or create their own with the approval of the DCC. Additionally, this will assist with bridging Entrepreneurship concepts in the P2 year until students re-visit in the P3 year.

<sup>1</sup> Students must complete and upload into E-value the fall selective activities by November 15<sup>th</sup> and the 1 required and 2 selective spring requirements by April 15<sup>th</sup>. Students must meet with their advisor and have activities signed off in E-Value by December 1 for the fall and May 1 for the spring.

<sup>2</sup>Selectives can be worked toward completion starting May of the P1 year and must be completed by April 15<sup>th</sup> of the P2 year. Students can select from pre-approved opportunities available on the Pharmacy Co-Curricular Blackboard site. Educational Outcome categorizes these opportunities. Students may also work with the Director of Co-Curriculum (DCC) to create their own.
